As a board member of the McColl Center, an artist residency and contemporary arts hub in Charlotte, N.C., Tyree is passionate about the value of art – and is eager to preserve Artistic Quilting's legacy for generations to come.

I've swum around creatives my entire career and think it's incredibly energizing – and I think it's good for the community when artists have the opportunity to create and grow," Tyree says.
